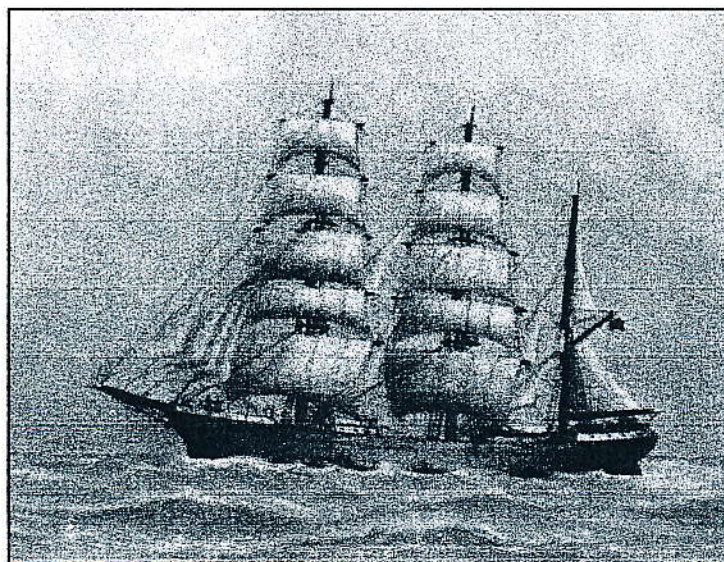

Chairperson's Annual Report

To All Members—2001

Looking back over the last 12 months I can only say that this year has been a good year. What makes a good year?. I think it's when you look back and you have achieved most of what you have planned .

We have had interesting meetings including speakers talking on Scottish and Irish research, early aviation pioneers, family stories, old traditions, old photographs and a session on improving your filing systems.

We organised two trips for the year, the first was to the Ballarat Genealogical Society and the second was a visit to the National Archives and the Public Records Office in Melbourne. Both days were well attended by members and have encouraged the committee to plan outings to places of interest in the new year.

The highlight of the year was the "Bridal Revival" which was a great success with many favourable comments from the community on how much they enjoyed the afternoon. Channel 9 television covered the function which was great promotion for Anglesea . My thanks go out to all the people who assisted to make this major fund raising a great success.

We have increased our purchase of family history records by \$700 this year and set up an Internet service available for members at the club rooms to help members with their research. We plan to continue to invest a similar amount of funds on new records in the new year so we can have a wider range of records for members. During the year we received a grant from the Surf Coast Shire as a contribution towards a Micro Film Reader. This would will allow us to hire film (possibly from the Mormon Library) and others. We would hope to make this acquisition during the new year.

We intend to become affiliated with the Genealogical Society of Victoria Inc in this new financial year and they will provide us with a list of Accredited Speakers and their topics and offer other benefits to our group. We have also appointed a Records Officer to purchase and to organise new records.

I would like to thank the committee and all of the members for their support and generosity over the past year and look forward to 2002. I send to you all my best wishes for Christmas and the new year.
